Monteiths crushed apple cider 330ml 4.5% NZ \$8.5

Monteiths crushed pear cider 330ml 4.5% NZ \$8.5

Hofbrau Original 5% Germany.

The beer of Bavarian royalty is one of the best examples of German Lager in the world. The most popular beer tent at Oktoberfest in Munich.

Amstel Light 330ml 2.5% NZ \$6

Lager / Ale / Pilsner

Moritz 330ml 5.4% Spain \$9

Tuatara Pilsner 330ml 5% NZ \$8

Crisp citrusy aroma with dry bitter finish

Mata Manuka 330ml 5% NZ \$9

A touch of Manuka honey makes this honey ale very palatable.

Mata Artesian 330ml 5% NZ \$9

A light and crisp ale with traditionally lower carbonation than a lager.

Fruit Beer / Lambic / Sour Ales

Brussels Red fruits 330ml 3.2% Belgium \$9.5

Pours cloudy copper orange, with fruity aroma and sweet berry taste

Brussels Peach 330ml 3.2% Belgium \$9.5

Pours cloudy dark yellow with aroma and taste of peaches, millions of peaches, peaches for me ☺

Kriek Belgique 330ml 3.5% Belgium \$8.8

Hazy dark red fruit beer with sweet cherry flavour and slightly sour finish

Apple white 250ml 3.1% Belgium \$7.5

Light yellow colour with aroma of apples and herbs.

Bellevue Kriek 300ml 5.1% Belgium \$11

A traditional Lambic beer with cherries thrown into the mix. The result is a refreshing beer with strong cherry aroma and a mild sourness from the cherries.

Timmermans Strawberry 330ml 4% Belgium \$12

Strawberries and beer. If you like your beer sweeter then go for the Timmermans range

Timmermans Framboise 330ml 4% Belgium \$12

Sweet and delicious. Raspberry's abound. Pushing the limits of being called a beer.

Timmermans Peach 330ml 4% Belgium \$12

Sweeter version of the Framboise with the peach flavour dominant.

Rodenbach Grand Cru 250ml 5.2% Belgium \$12

In Belgium the slogan used to be "It's not for everyone" Sharp puckering finish. Fruity and if you search for it on the third sip some sweetness comes through.

Porter / Stout / Dunkel

North Coast Old Rasputin Russian Imperial Stout 330ml 9% USA \$15

Is this the best stout around? Full of flavour and so strong and robust. Sweet with chocolate and caramel. Great bitterness to balance.

Tuatara Porter 330ml 5% NZ \$8.5

Toasty malt with a slight hint of bitter chocolate. A good standard porter.

Gosser Dark 500ml 4.2% Austria \$10

Dark ruby colour with chocolate and roasted malts in the taste. Aroma of sweet honey.

IPA / APA / Pale Ale

Epic Pale Ale 330ml 5.4% NZ \$8

Epic uses large amounts of hops to get great taste and aroma.

Epic IPA Armageddon 500ml 6.66% NZ \$16

Not for the uninitiated. Just the smell of this is amazing with passion fruit and grapefruit sweetness vying for control of your senses. The taste is pine and orange, grapefruit and lemon with a slight caramel balance. Great bitter finish makes this a beer you can drink all day.

Amber ale

Palm 330ml 5.4% Belgium \$8.5

The most popular beer in Flemish Belgium. An amber beer with a good mixture of light hops and sweetness. Great first step away from standard lagers.

Corsendonk Rouse 330ml 8% Belgium \$9.8

Pours a clear amber with medium white head. Some sugar and caramel with notes of herbal hops. Medium bodied and smooth. Semi sweet at the front with medium bitterness to finish.

La Gauloise Ambree 330ml 5.5% Belgium \$9.2

Amber coloured pour with fine thick head. Aroma of hops with a slight hint of liquorice. Pronounced bitterness yet mellow and thirst-quenching.

Barleywine / Eisbock

Thomas Hardy Ale (2005 Vintage) 250ml 11.7% England \$19

No, that is not a misprint. It really is \$19 for 250ml of beer. This scarce and complex beer ages like a fine wine and has continued to improve with age. The oldest and some say the best is 26 years old. We have the 2005 Vintage and you can see why some consider this beer to be the beer enthusiast's cognac. Not for the faint of palate. Some would suggest we cellar this until 2015 before serving. Others like the younger more brash flavours.

Schnieder Aventinus Eisbock 12% Germany \$18

How do you make a strong beer stronger and more potent? Answer, freeze it slowly and remove the ice. Strong and Sweet.

Wheat beer

Celis White 250ml 5% Belgium \$6.9

Pierre Celis created the original Hoegaarden beer in the early 1960's. Interbrew-Labatt bought the brand and the brewery in the 1980's. Pierre Celis formed a new brewery in Austin Texas, brewing the same beer but under the brand name Celis White. Miller bought the Celis brewery and the Celis White brand-name in 1996. The brewery closed in 2000. In late 2002 Michigan Brewing bought the Celis White brand from Miller. Brouwerij Van Steenberge is now brewing the original Pierre Celis White under the brand-name Celis White in Europe and Ertveld's Wit in North America.

Blanche De Namur 330ml 4.5% Belgium \$8.4

Blond and cloudy. The cloudy appearance is created at low temperature but disappears when the beer gets warmer. Fine fruity with a scent of the used spice, coriander and bitter orange. Smooth beer, thirst-quenching but mild, slightly acidulous.

Edelweiss Snowfresh 330ml 5% Austria \$9

A delicious wheat beer with a nice alpine herb aroma.

Schneider Weisse 500ml 5.4% Germany \$14

Banana, cloves and nutmeg flavours in this 60% wheat 40% barley bottle conditioned beer.

Hoegaarden 330ml 4.9% Belgium \$9

Unfiltered Belgian white beer with coriander and orange peel flavourings

Belgian blonde / Belgian ale

If you are new to Belgian beers then this is the place to start.

Augustijn Blonde 330ml 6.5% Belgium \$9.2

Well balanced golden beer with a fruity taste and a light bitter finish. Superb beer to start on.

Corsendonk Tempelier 330ml 6% Belgium \$9.2

The latest beer from the excellent Corsendonk range. This is light 6% beer. Colour is darker blond to amber. Aroma of fruits, malt and spice. Taste is sweet, malty, spicy, some fruits with a dry finish.

La Gauloise Blonde 330ml 6.3% Belgium \$9.9

Blond, bright and sparkling with a fine and creamy head. Fragrance of fine hops. Delicate mellow flavour.

St Benoit Blonde 330ml 6.3% Belgium \$9.5

Beautiful straw colour, fine white head. Fruity aroma with a slight flavour of hops. Smooth beer, pleasantly sweet with a light bitterness

Orval 330ml 6.2% Belgium \$15

In contrast to all the others, the Orval Trappist brewery makes only one beer for the general public. It has an intensely aromatic and dry character. Between the first and second fermentations there is also an additional dry-hopping process. Through this the beer acquires its pronounced hoppy aroma and extra dry taste with a sourness on the finish. Bottled at 5.2% abv - can go up as high as 7.2%

Belgian strong dark ale

Leute bokbier 330ml 7.5% Belgium \$10.5

Leute Bok ale is a dark red heavy beer, top fermented and re-fermented in the bottle. The aroma and taste is unique and striking, not too sweet, but full and smooth on the tongue.

Trois Pistoles 330ml 9% Canada \$15

Canada makes an appearance here with their Montreal based Unibroue Brewery. This is a great example of sweetness and alcohol blending very well in a dark beer.

Double / Dubbel / Doppelbock /

Aventinus Doppelbock 500ml 8.2% Germany \$15

Dark ruby colour, streaked with fine top-fermented yeast. This beer has a compact, stable and long-lasting head. An intensive banana and clove-like aroma. It is full-bodied, compact and yet fresh with a hint of caramel.

La Gauloise Brune 330ml 8.1% Belgium \$11.9

Dark reddish brown, clear, living beer with a fine and generous white head. Scent of coriander and special malts. Full mouth feel with balanced, slightly bitter aftertaste.

St Benoit Brune 330ml 6.5% Belgium \$10.9

Dark brown pour with light brown head. Aroma rye, brown bread and brown sugar. Flavour is sweet malty, slightly roasted and with some dark fruits and a tiny hint of molasses. Thick body and decent carbonation.

Augustijn Donker 330ml 7% Belgium \$9.2

Pours a clear copper with cream head. Aroma of toasted grain, brown sugar, and Belgian yeast. Flavour of raisin, caramel, slight coriander and brown sugar.

Bornem Dubbel 330ml 8% Belgium \$9.5

Very dark, coffee colour. Full rich body with lasting head. Effervescent nose and a soft velvet feeling in the mouth. Malt character with a hoppy after touch.

Rochefort 6 330ml 7.5% Belgium \$13

Reddish brown in colour, taste is earthy, herbal and spicy with caramel on the finish.

Rochefort 8 330ml 9.2% Belgium \$15

Stronger and more complex than the 6, balanced well with fruity notes and caramel.

Waterloo Dubbel 8 Dark 330ml 8% Belgian \$10.8

This traditional Belgian beer finds its origin in 1815 at the time of the battle of Waterloo. Its old fashioned brewing process from malt and hops finely selected gives it a strong, tasty and vigorous character. Delicious fragrance of fresh yeast outlined by scents of fruit. Light bitterness with a touch of caramel and roasted malt. Smooth beer with strong personality yet in harmonious balance.

Corsendonk Pater 330ml 7.5% Belgium \$9.8

Has a very distinctive bouquet: some residual yeast, darker stone fruits and slightly smoky. In palate, it has notes of port, raisins and black chocolate. High Carbonation. A very highly rated and popular beer.

Westmalle Dubbel 330ml 7% Belgium \$13

Westmalle is a Trappist brewery from Belgium that produces two of the world's best beers. This dubbel is nutty caramel with some dark fruits.

Belgian strong pale ale

Duvel Golden Ale 330ml 8.5% Belgium \$13.5

Duvel has a very complex brewing process using only the finest hops. The result is a dry yet very refreshing beer with high carbonation.

Augustijn Grand Cru 330ml 9% Belgium \$10.5

Full body - staying head - amber colour with a spicy, malty palate that finishes very fruity with complex hoppy undertones. Brewed with permission from the Augustijn Abbey in Gent.

Kwak 330ml 8.2% Belgium \$15

As Belgian as they come. Sweet, malty and rich. Served in possibly the most ridiculous glass around.

Corsendonk Agnus 330ml 7.5% Belgium \$10.5

Light and citrus with a delicate hop character at the finish. Very good beer!

Piraat 330ml 10.5% Belgium \$12.5

This is the lighter coloured Gulden Draak. Deep golden with a subtle haze. Lots of hops and malt. Mild sweetness. Reminiscent of bread dough, spices and tropical fruits. Huge punch at 10.5% and like most of the stronger beers mellows mid beer and the taste really starts to come out.

St Sylvestre 3 Monts 750ml 8.5% France \$28

Very good traditionally brewed beer from France. Called a 'Biere de Garde', one for keeping and will age well.

Delerium Tremens 330ml 8.5% Belgium \$15

Voted best beer in the world at the '1998 Chicago world beer championships'. Three different types of yeast are used to create the unique taste and character.

Tripel

Bornem Tripel 330ml 9% Belgium **\$12**

Malty, fruity taste with dried fruit, orange marmalade and a generous, spicy bitterness in a finish with a certain alcohol bite. Lovely sweetness to finish.

Waterloo Tripel 7 330ml 7.5% Belgian **\$12**

Waterloo Tripel is brewed on huge amounts of pilsener malt. Aromatic Saazer and Spalter hops are added, but to no further extent than to give it a bitterness equal to a pilsener which gives more room to the beer's sweetness. The beer is fermented with Du Bocq's original yeast strain which is responsible for the delicate, spicy expression. After maturation and filtration the beer has a secondary fermentation in the bottle which causes its slight cloudiness.

Tripel Moine 330ml 7.3% Belgium **\$12**

Blond, living beer with a fine and generous head. Balanced association of green apple fruit and fine hop. Light bitterness. Smooth beer with character.

Gulden Draak 330ml 10.5% Belgium **\$12.5**

This is a dark Triple which differs from most tripels that are traditionally golden. Malty toffee like sweetness and a very warming alcohol content combine superbly well to make this a Gothenburg favourite.

Westmalle Tripel 330ml 9.5% Belgium **\$14**

Strong, dry and spicy, one of the best tripels around.

La Fin du Monde 330ml 9% Belgium **\$15**

Canadian gem. Golden colour, golden taste.

Quadrupel / ABV

Rochefort 10 330ml 11.3% Belgium **\$17**

This is the best beer we have. Beware it has 11.3% that is so well hidden you can drink it like a 5%
